- **Research interests**

My research interests lie in the field of glaucoma and specifically in the surgical management of glaucoma. To this end I have completed more than 2 years of clinical research, running a comparative trial of unaugmented and 5-Fluorouracil augmented trabeculectomy in an east Asian population (**The Singapore 5-Fluorouracil trabeculectomy study**). This was conducted from 2002 to 2004 at Singapore National Eye Centre – during this time I was an employee of the Institute of Ophthalmology, London, UK. For this research I have been awarded the degree of MD (Res) Clinical Research by University of London, UK.

I am currently the direction of the Regional Eye System for SingHealth which is a body overseeing new models of care within the eye healthcare system. I have over 60 publications in peer reviewed journals. I am currently involved in 16 research studies.
