I was also a key member in the setting up and implementation of the Cluster Hospital project in Hospital Tuanku Ampuan Najihah, Kuala Pilah during my time there in 2015 – 2016 as a gazetted specialist and general ophthalmologist. During my time there, I also embarked on increasing the number of cataract surgery cases per OT session (from 5-6 cases previously to 10 cases) to better utilise the OT time.

While doing my fellowship in Vitreo-retina at Hospital Sultanah Bahiyah, Alor Setar (2017-2018), I also initiated a community-based project to involve the private optometrists in Alor Setar and Sungai Petani in diabetic retinopathy screening and setting up a referral system between the general practitioners and the private optometrists.
